

A Story of Hope As Youngest Premature Baby to Survive in Gurgaon Goes Home Healthy

From the land, which is infamous for female feticide and screwed sex ratio, an inspiring story where doctors went extra mile to save premature baby girl born at 23 Weeks

Gurgaon: Baby Taranum described as **#WonderBaby**, was born four months prematurely at 23 weeks gestation, has been discharged from hospital after defying the odds.

Baby Taranum was born at 23 weeks gestation, weighing barely 650 gms, was born without any major complication is possibly the most premature baby to survive in the country without even single blood transfusion, say doctors who nursed the child for almost four months in a neonate intensive care unit of Artemis Hospital. Born in January, Baby Taranum, spent nearly four months in the hospital before been released in good health at the end of April.

Worldwide, the survival of a preterm infant born at 23 weeks is considered an achievement of sorts. "Even developed countries would not revive babies, premature than this, since the chances of survival and normal development are bleak. It is a miracle even more surprising as apart from some expected respiratory issue, Baby Taranum appears to be doing well; her prognosis is excellent." said Dr. Prabhat Maheshwari- Head, NICU (Artemis Hospitals)

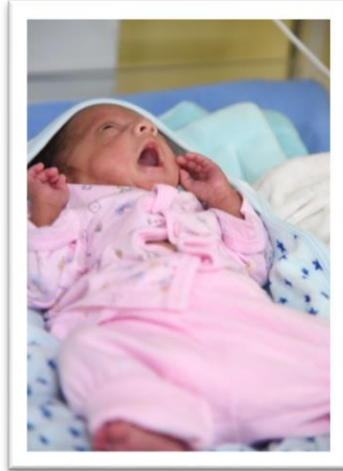
